Sustainability

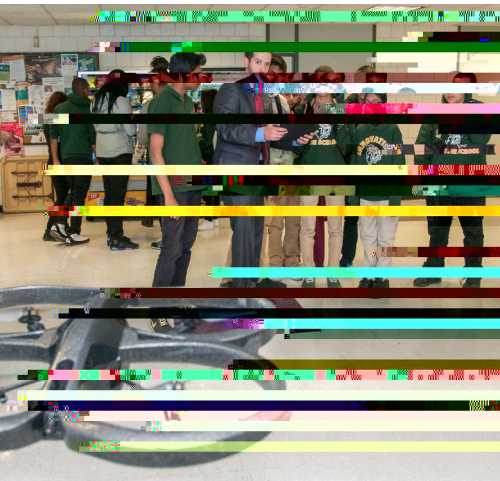

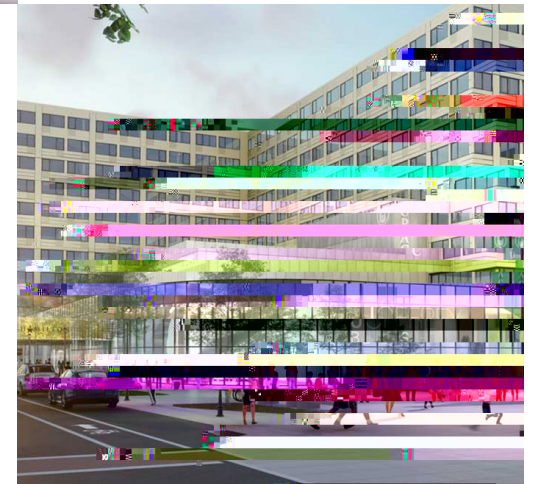
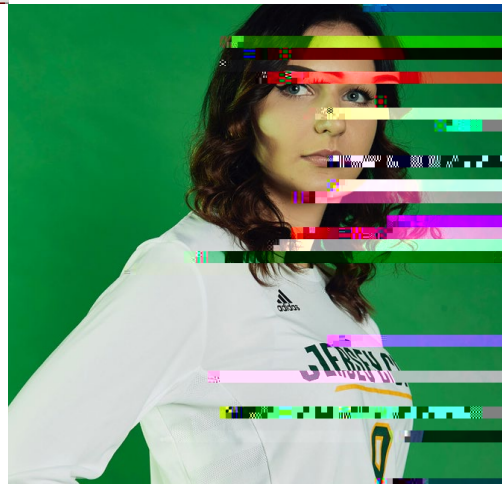
Our Communities
