

**TUITION REMISSION PROGRAM FOR DEPENDENT CHILDREN/
SIBLINGS OR SPOUSE/DOMESTIC PARTNER OF FULL-TIME
EMPLOYEES**

A. General Program Description

The tuition waiver program provides partial waiver of tuition costs at New Jersey City University for eligible dependent children/siblings of full-time University employees. To receive this waiver the student must fulfill the academic and administrative requirements for admission, apply for all available State and Federal grants and scholarships, and receive a passing grade. The cost of tuition only is waived. If the student does not receive a passing grade for the course(s) for which the waiver has been granted, reimbursement to the University for all-waived costs will be required. Until this is done no other waivers will be granted. All fees and additional charges are the responsibility of the student. Children/Siblings (biological, legally adopted) do not meet the qualifications for independent student status – the child is 24 years of age or older, is not a veteran of the U.S. armed forces, the child is

C. Employees Employees must remain in a full-time status. If an employee loses full-time status the tuition waiver will cease and the status changed.

D. Children/Siblings Must be completing their first baccalaureate degree program. Tuition waivers are for Fall and Spring semesters. Student must submit a FAFSA form. Tuition waiver must be submitted each semester. The student and employee must pay for that semester.

E. Amount of Waiver for Dependent Children/Siblings The University will waive 60% of tuition not including fees for programs leading to the first baccalaureate degree. Credits required for completion. In no case will the waiver exceed twelve semesters or the number of credits required for completion.
